Recruitment update




250 participants have been recruited into OPTIMA.

39 participants were randomised in October which was our highest in-month total to-date!

Mount Vernon Cancer Centre, Bristol Haematology and Oncology Centre and University Hospital Coventry were joint top recruiters in October, each recruiting 3 participants.


Please remember to ask your next potential OPTIMA patient if you can make a recording.
