## June 2018 Recruitment tip of the month: Sharing your belief in the study with patients

When talking with patients about possible OPTIMA treatment allocations it's good to clearly state that you are comfortable with the patient receiving either allocation i.e. chemotherapy followed by hormone therapy or hormone therapy alone:

"I'm very happy for you to be entered in the study and to follow the treatment that you would be given, whatever that may be". (Recruitment appointment)

#### **Treatment Allocation Timelines**

Time from Randomisation to notification of Treatment Allocation is estimated to be **2-4 weeks**. Currently, we are seeing a much quicker turnaround, but this is not guaranteed.

For blocks received before Wednesday lunchtime, we expect the result to be available the following Monday, but <u>this is not guaranteed</u>; Prosigna test failure and additional tests being required can delay the release of results to WCTU, which in turn will delay us sending the allocations out to site.

Blocks received after Wednesday lunchtime will be held over until the processing run the following week.
