Recruitment tip of the month: Check that you are identifying all eligible OPTIMA patients

If you haven't done so recently, December is a good time to review your system for flagging potential OPTIMA patients at your MDT. Do you have an OPTIMA champion at the MDT? Are your fellow MDT members au fait with the study? We've produced Guidance notes for Surgeons and Breast Nurse Specialists and a laminated summary of the eligibility criteria for MDT meetings – for further copies, please contact the OPTIMA trial office.

Having flagged a patient at MDT, check that your system for relaying this to the research nurse and other staff that will meet the patient, is working.

Identifying all eligible patients is an essential early step for optimising recruitment.

OPTIMA Tissue Transit Form

We understand that completing the Tissue Transit Form is not always straightforward so hope you find this annotated version helpful. Please remember that the trials office are more than happy to answer any queries you may have.

Confirmation of consent can be signed by any one on the delegation log.

Please enter the total number of tumour blocks sent to the Central Lab.

The form needs to be signed by a member of staff delegated to "Completion of Tissue Transit Form" NB: only trial investigators or pathologists who are members of the breast MDT can have this responsibility delegated.

This is important for the safety of the trial to ensure samples are tracked correctly.

We need the DoB and initials to ensure the patient details on this form match the tumour sample submitted to the central lab.

If more than one block is sent, ensure you complete <u>one</u> form for <u>each</u> block.

Amending the Tissue transit form:

Corrections to the form can be completed by anyone on the delegation log <u>apart</u> from updates to:

- histology number
- block number
- tumour size
- number of involved nodes

 $These \ must \ be \ countersigned \ by \ the \ PI \ / \ someone \ on \ the \ log \ who \ has \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ Transit \ Form \ \ \ \ \ delegated \ to \ them.$



Screening logs are now due. The data that you send provides a valuable insight into what is happening at site level and collectively across the 90+ OPTIMA sites. Please can we ask you to complete them as fully as possible every month.
